Dear Parent/Carer

What will the curriculum at Outwood Academy Hemsworth look like for my son/daughter who is in Y10?

Our aim is to provide students with a broad and balanced curriculum, and support them to achieve the highest possible grades, and ensure that they have the best possible life chances. Our Guided Pathways process supports this vision. We have tried to develop a curriculum that is innovative and knowledge rich, with a focus on the basics of English and Maths, whilst making certain that we fulfil their entitlement to study the full suite of EBacc subjects.

The table below outlines how your son/daughter's curriculum will develop from Y10 into Y11. In summary the table shows:

- The number of hours per week of each subject area (HPW)
- Students chose their guided pathways subjects in Y9 and will aim to complete them in Y10 (Option 1 - 3)
- Non EBacc subjects will certify at the end of Y10. EBacc subjects (History, Geography, French, Spanish and Computer Science) will certify in Y11
- Students studying EBacc subjects will have between 2-4 hours of consolidation time in their chosen EBacc pathway. Students are already aware of how this consolidation time is used.

A key part of this curriculum is the opportunity for students to start the deeper study of some subjects as they move into Year 10 and 11. Some of these subjects can be certified at the end of Year 10, and some at the end of Year 11. One of the advantages of this model is that it enables students to spread out the examination load. A further advantage is that it enables students to pick additional subjects or receive extra support in English and Maths in Y11.
