

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to announce the return of the popular Outwood Masterclass series for students in Years 7-9. The aim of our masterclass series is to inspire and challenge students to go further in their learning journeys, providing them with the opportunity to develop and extend their curriculum beyond the classroom. Each Masterclass has been written and delivered by a member of staff from one of the academies across Outwood Grange Academies Trust. As explained in the parent/carer video, students will access each masterclass using a dedicated [Masterclass Google Site](#) and they will register their attendance using a registration form which they should reach by clicking on the student resource sheet for each masterclass rather than the main registration form on the link. Students should make sure that they are **logged into their Google account when they do this.**

Each academy will reward students with 'gold', 'silver' and 'bronze' certificates to acknowledge their effort and engagement. Each masterclass is pre-recorded and has resources and links embedded within the site. This means that students can complete their Masterclass either in the school library at lunchtime, in Homework Club after school or at home at a time that suits them; they can even return to a masterclass if they haven't completed it in one session. Each Masterclass is approximately one hour and covers the core subjects of English Maths and Science, with additional Masterclasses in Geography, History, Design Technology and RE/Life. We have also provided a useful QR code for the Masterclasses on page 24 of this year's student planner.

Each week we will send out reminders to students through tutor time as well as regular updates to parents/carers using our text messaging services and social media. Should you have any questions about our Masterclass enrichment programme please do not hesitate to contact the academy.
