Year Group Blocks Are No

Longer

- Students will access lessons all over the school site following a one way system
- Staff will be given a classroom that they teach most lessons from

Key Features?

One Way System (during lesson change over)

Tech Block: Enter via the Art Gallery, exit via bottom doors. After P5 students can leave via the Art Gallery.

Science Block: Enter via doors near Cherry Tree House, exit using the top doors near Reception

Main Block Lower: Enter and exit via any door, but must travel clockwise

Main Block Upper: Enter via stairs leading to U1. Exit via other stairs

Key Features?

Punctuality

- All students will receive a C4 other if they are late to any lessons (30 minute detention)
- It is expected that students are on time for Tutor time
For all other lessons you will have a 5 minutes movement time

One Way System (during lesson change over)

Humanities: Enter and exit using the main door

Three Storey: Enter via doors closest to Main Block (L5), exit using the stairs near the Cafe/Site Office

Sports Centre: Same as currently
