Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you are well.

Further to my letter to you on 7 January, I am writing to confirm that the partial closure that was implemented for Y8 from Monday 10 January to Thursday 13 January will be extended to include **Friday 14 January**. Unfortunately, we continue to have a significant number of staff absences and therefore we cannot fully staff their lessons and keep students safe. We continue to struggle to secure supply staff from agencies which has resulted in the academy having to make the decision to extend the closure to Y8. However, the academy will reopen to Y8 on Monday 17 January. If a further partial closure is required next week, we will ensure that this will not affect Y8 students.

### Home Learning

We have previously communicated with you last year to explain what the process will be for setting work for students during the enforced closure. Therefore, whilst at home, Google Classroom is the means by which teachers will set work for their classes. In order for parents/carers to support their children at home, we have created a [Home Learning webpage](http://homelearning.outwood.com) (homelearning.outwood.com) which provides you with guidance on how to access Google Classroom with your child.

Lessons will be available for all subjects and the timings of each lesson will follow the school day. For each lesson there will be work and resources uploaded to Google Classroom. The independent work which they will then complete at home should then be submitted to their usual teacher via Google Classroom. If your child is unable to access work from home, please contact Gary Ives on the email above to arrange for support from the academy.
