As a school we are committed to safeguarding our students and ensuring that parents/carers are fully informed about any ongoing concerns about social media trends and the impact this can have on our young people.

You may be aware of a craze that has gone viral on Tik Tok called the 'Blackout Challenge' or the 'Tap Out Challenge.'


The 'Blackout Challenge' involves a child holding their breath until they pass out, needless to say, this is alarming and extremely dangerous.

The 'Tap Out Challenge' is when one person is held in a 'choke hold' by another child with their neck squeezed until they almost pass out, the child then taps the other when they want them to stop. This is also deeply concerning and unsafe. If students engage in this behaviour it places them in imminent danger and at risk of serious harm, which can result in long-term damage.

We are underway with engaging with students about this activity to highlight the risks, but I would very much appreciate your support and ask that you also have these same discussions with your child, allowing us to work together to protect our young people.
