Y11 Mock Exams and Intervention

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am pleased to be able to share with you the final details of the mock exams that your child will complete during the upcoming mock exam period. **Mock exams begin on Monday 19th February and run until Wednesday 6th March.** These mock exams are an important part of the work that your child is completing to prepare for their GCSE summer examinations which begin in May.

At Outwood Academy Hemsworth we want to ensure that your child is fully prepared for the summer examinations and we hope that you will fully support us in delivering a successful mock examination period.

These mock exams will:

- Ensure that your child fully understands the formal JCQ examination regulations, and how GCSE exams will run in May.
- Enable students to practise their revision techniques, and the feedback they receive from these mock exams will indicate what students need to focus their revision on.
- Provide your child's teachers with a clear indication of where they may need additional support to be able to achieve their full potential during the summer 2024 exam period.
