
Suggested by Ruth Frampton from Outwood Academy Brumby **treeapp** lets you plant a tree a day to offset your carbon emission!

# Focus on: Outwood Academy Hemsworth

Climate change and sustainability is at the heart of everything we do at Outwood Academy Hemsworth. We felt privileged to host the Student Voice conference at Elland Road last December. Since then, we have been working hard on our 5 action points. All tutor groups take part in litter picking during tutor time with a focus on separating recyclable and non recyclable materials, our year 7 tutor representatives have planted 50 trees within the school grounds, we now use recycled paper within the academy, we have abolished plastic cutlery within the canteen and we are currently building a large statue during Technology enrichment which will eventually be used as a large recycling bin for our plastic bottles. Our students have recently taken part in Planet League, which involved completing different actions to be more sustainable to score goals for Leeds United. We also hosted a competition within the academy to see which staff and students could score the most goals. We are looking forward to making our next steps to becoming more sustainable, including creating art work made from recycled bottle tops and taking part in activities relating to National Walking Month in May and World Environment Day in June.
