Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you are well.

Unfortunately, we have a significant number of staff absences. As a result, I have made the decision to close the school for all of **Year 8 from Wednesday 30 March to Friday 1 April, returning on Monday 4 April 2022**, as we cannot staff their lessons and keep students safe. Finding staff from agencies is also incredibly difficult and often we cannot get supply teachers in.

Home Learning - Streamed Lessons

During this partial closure, the academy will provide the majority of sessions as live-streamed lessons. Due to absence, the staff member delivering this lesson may not be your child's normal classroom teacher but will be a subject specialist. Students will start with a **live streamed tutor session at 8.25am** each day hosted by Mr Baker who will remind them how to find the codes for the rest of their lessons during the partial closure as well as deliver a tutor time activity. **The link for the tutor session and all live-streamed lessons will be in your child's Year Group Google classroom.** As part of our drive to ensure high engagement with online learning, we will be monitoring student attendance to lessons using a Google registration form which will also be provided by the teacher delivering the streamed lesson. In the Core subjects, we aim to provide lessons for students in both sets 1/2 and 3/4 to help provide the additional support some students may need. Some students follow a literacy intervention pathway instead of studying Spanish, this will also be provided as part of the timetable.

Lessons will be available for all subjects and the timings of each lesson will follow the school day (please note the lunch period for Year 8 will be 12.00-12.30). If your child is unable to log into Google Classroom (for example, if they have forgotten their password) please contact Dani Wheeler d.wheeler@hemsworth.outwood.com

If your child is unable to access work from home, please contact Mrs Wheeler using the email above to arrange for support from the academy.
